## Public Holidays Ordinance (Cap. 81) (Section 6, 9)

## ORDER

(Alteration of days appointed to be public holidays)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 6 of the Public Holidays Ordinance (Cap. 81), I hereby declare the following days to be public holidays for 2022.

Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> January In honour of New Year's Day Tuesday, 8th March, In honour of International Women's Day Friday, 8th April In honour of World Health Day Friday, 15th April Good Friday Monday, 18th April Easter Monday Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May In honour of International Labour Day Friday 8th July In honour of Gospel Day Monday, 11th July National Culture and Senior Citizens Day Tuesday, 12th July National Day Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> July Kiribati Special Day Friday, 5th August National Youth & Children's Day Wednesday, 5<sup>th</sup> October World Teachers Day Monday 12th December In honour of Human Rights Day Monday, 26th December In honour of Christmas Day Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> December In honour of Boxing Day (Gift Day)

I further declare that any day appointed to be a public holiday under section 2 of the Ordinance that does not appear in the list above shall be a public holiday in 2022.

The order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st of January 2022 and any Order previously made for the same purpose shall be null and void.
